

palliAGEDnurse - Now available for download



Technology is helping us to find information and resources more quickly. Decision Assist's second app, palliAGEDnurse, now helps nurses working in residential aged care, community care and general practice to care for older people with palliative care needs.

The app highlights a care framework built around three care processes – advance care planning, palliative care cases conferences and a care plan for the dying person. Nurses can navigate quickly to the three care processes. More specific information relevant to their practice setting can also be retrieved.

An online-offline capacity means they can use the app anywhere in Australia. As the app is web-based, it can be updated as new evidence and resources are released. palliAGEDnurse is free to download.

palliAGEDnurse is being developed by the CareSearch Project Team at Flinders University as part of the Decision Assist Program. It is a companion to the successful palliAGEDgp app.

For those nurses who may not have a smartphone, have a phone that does not meet current software standards, or who may prefer to use web-based resources or view content on their tablet - for optimal user experience, we would recommend viewing the palliAGEDnurse content online through your web browser at apps.caresearch.com.au/palliAGEDnurse/home.

A desktop shortcut can be created using Internet Explorer which will display the palliAGEDnurse icon on your desktop, this will give the appearance of the app whilst providing rapid access to web version of palliAGEDnurse.
