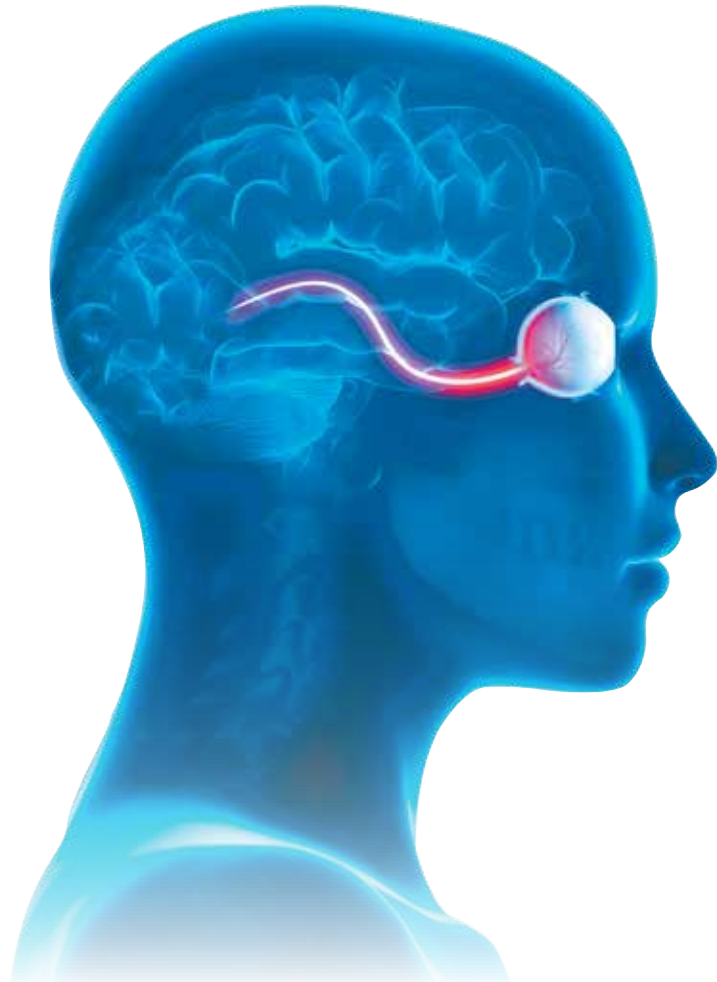

Recent advances in cataract surgery

A/Prof. Geoffrey Painter MB BS FRANZCO FRACS

The presenter will discuss technological advances that have made cataract surgery both safer and more precise. Three of the most recent technological advances will be presented and their importance to patients emphasised.

A/Prof. Geoffrey Painter undertook ophthalmology training at the Sydney Eye Hospital and Addenbrooke's Hospital in Cambridge. He co-founded Gordon Eye Surgery, where he continues in private practice specialising in cataract surgery and glaucoma. He is an AMO at Dalcross & Sydney Adventist Hospitals and was appointed A/Professor at Sydney Adventist Hospital Clinical School in 2010.

Laser Cataract Surgery and Vitamins for AMD

Dr Andrew Kaines MB BS MPH FRANZCO

This presentation will discuss the advantages and disadvantages of laser assisted cataract surgery compared with manual cataract surgery. Relevant eye tests for distinguishing dry and wet AMD as well as macuvision and other vitamin supplements used in dry AMD will be discussed.

Dr Andrew Kaines is a specialist ophthalmologist and ophthalmic surgeon, with expertise in the diagnosis and treatment of the macula and retina, including macular degeneration and diabetic eye disease. He undertook international fellowship positions at London's Moorfields Eye Hospital and the Jules Stein Institute, UCLA, California.

Primary open angle glaucoma and new micro surgical treatments

Dr Steven Wine MBBS UNSW FRANZCO

This presentation will give an overview of the diagnosis, investigation and treatment of glaucoma. An emphasis will be placed on the new micro surgical treatments available for glaucoma, and the combination of these with cataract surgery.

Dr Steven Wine is a general ophthalmologist in clinical practice in Hornsby. He has a special interest in combined cataract glaucoma surgery. He is on the medical advisory council for the San Day Surgery Hornsby.

Migraine and Headache

Dr Sara Booth-Mason MBBS, MRCP(UK), FRCS, FRC Ophth (UK), FRANZCO

The presenter will discuss different types of ophthalmic conditions that can present with headache. Symptoms that require more urgent investigation, different types of migraine and giant cell arteritis will be discussed.

Dr Sara Booth-Mason is a general ophthalmologist with interests in medical and neuro-ophthalmology. She trained at St Thomas' Hospital and Moorfields Eye Hospital in London. She co-founded Gordon Eye Surgery and is an AMO at Dalcross & Sydney Adventist Hospitals.
