

# Remember Me

A dementia specific hospital discharge program

The primary goal of this program is to facilitate the smooth transition of a person, living with dementia, from hospital to home.

*No more bed blockages*

*No last minute delays*

*Fewer re-admissions*

*No one left drinking cold cups of tea in the Discharge Lounge*

## **The KinCare Case Manager will:**

- Assess patient's on the ward and liaise with social workers/ discharge planners;
- Liaise with transport providers and support clients to attend follow-up appointments made by medical teams and social worker;
- Maintain and improve communication between GP's, Specialists, personal support network – carer(s), family/ friends and other health/community service support providers; and
- Ensure any referrals made in hospital to My Aged Care progress to an assessment in which a Dementia specific Support Plan is established and maintained.

'Remember Me' aims to provide an opportunity for hospital staff and the community care sector to work together on the ward, so that a patient with Dementia is able to leave hospital once medically cleared for discharge.
