The HammondCare Palliative Care At Home Program

This program provides care for patients who wish to remain in their home for end of life care. A range of multidisciplinary clinicians, including specialised carers, are available to provide home-based support to the patients and their families and/or carers.

Services provided to patients are based on ongoing assessment of individual need and preference, including medical, nursing, psychosocial support, respite, personal care, allied health and equipment provision. A bereavement care follow-up service is also available to carers and families.

The primary goal of the program is to provide a holistic personal experience tailored to individuals needs and provided in the comfort of their own home. Medibank is funding HammondCare to provide this pilot program to Medibank members who reside in parts of Northern Sydney, hold an eligible Medibank hospital insurance policy, and meet eligibility requirements.
