

DONATED FACE MASKS

- SNHN has received, free of charge, donated surgical face masks which SNHN believes are manufactured by Henan Tuoren Medical Device Co. Ltd, a Chinese company.
- By law, all medical devices must be included on the Australian Register of Therapeutic Goods before they can be lawfully supplied in Australia. Surgical face masks are a kind of medical device.
- SNHN has been informed that the donated face masks are sponsored (a requirement of the Therapeutic Goods Administration) by Dedicare Pty Ltd, an Australian company.
- SNHN believes there is currently an approval to supply certificate issued by the Therapeutic Goods Administration to Dedicare Pty Ltd in respect of "mask, surgical, single use" with the Global Medical Device Nomenclature 35177. In the certificate, Dedicare is listed as the sponsor and Henan Tuoren is listed as the manufacturer of the medical device.
- According to the Therapeutic Goods Administration certificate, the intended purpose of the medical device is as follows:

A device intended to be placed over the nose and mouth of personnel to prevent the transmission of airborne organisms.

- SNHN is reliant on Dedicare that the donated face masks have been imported to Australia in compliance with the Therapeutic Goods Administration certificate and that they are manufactured by Henan Touren and sponsored by Dedicare.
- Please note that SNHN has not independently verified any of this information.
- SNHN has also not assessed and makes no representations as to the quality, characteristics, manufacturing process, safety, suitability or fitness for purpose of the donated face masks.
- SNHN is offering to donate these face masks to you free of charge, and it is entirely your decision whether you choose to accept the donation and use them in your clinic / practice. Any enquiries regarding the face masks should be directed to Dedicare Pty Ltd.
