Professor Gillatt gained more than 20 years' experience in all areas of urology as a leading prostate and bladder cancer surgeon.

In 2008, Professor Gillatt introduced a robotically assisted surgery program and has performed over 1000 cases. He introduced and designed a systematic method of training for both established surgeons and trainees on the robot console. He is well known for introducing the Enhanced Recovery program for cystectomy, which was the first of its kind globally.
