<input type="checkbox"/> Connect to a Prescription Delivery Service (PDS). <small>Existing services include eRx and MediSecure</small>	The Electronic Prescription is transmitted from the GP's prescribing software to the PDS which the pharmacy can then access patient prescription in the PDS.	Register for eRx <a href="#">here</a> OR Register for MediSecure <a href="#">here</a>
<input type="checkbox"/> HPI-O Ensure your Pharmacy has a Healthcare Provider Identifier-Organisation and is connected to the HI Service	This is a core requirement for Electronic Prescribing. If your Pharmacy is already connected to My Health Record, you do not need to complete this step.	To register your Pharmacy for a HPI-O click <a href="#">here</a>
<input type="checkbox"/> QR Barcode scanner	To process an Electronic Prescription you will need to be able to scan QR code tokens presented on a patient's phone or printed copy.	View the recommended scanner <a href="#">here</a>
<input type="checkbox"/> Embed a workflow process and/or tool to manage Electronic Prescriptions	For easy management of paper and Electronic Prescriptions into the one electronic workflow. It can be used with any dispensing software.	For more MedView Flow information, click <a href="#">here</a>
