- For Northern Beaches, GPs can refer to the GEM unit (PH: 02 9998 6271)

> What types of patients would be suitable to discuss with the Geriatrician?

• Yes- All patients (mostly aged 65 and over), particularly those at risk of hospitalisation over the next few months. Common topics may include: medication management, frailty, cognition impairment, falls, depression, and other age-related issues.

> What will this look like?
