HEALTH DRIVERS

Hunters Hill LGA is an affluent area, ranking in the least disadvantaged quintile (20%) on the index of relative socio-economic disadvantage. There is a small area of comparatively high socio-economic disadvantage in the suburb of Woolwich.

CANCER SCREENING

Bowel cancer screening participation rate among people aged **50-74 years in Hunters Hill (42.4%)** is higher than the SNHN (38.6%) and NSW (35.4%) rates.

Cervical cancer screening participation rate among women aged **20-69 years (68.6%)** is higher than both SNHN (62.7%) and NSW (55.9%) rates.

Breast cancer screening participation rate among women aged **50-74 years in Hunters Hill (41.8%)** is similar to the SNHN (41.8%) rate and lower than the NSW (46.1%) rate.

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


