CANCER SCREENING

Bowel cancer screening participation rate among people aged **50-74 years in Lane Cove (38.8%)** is similar to the SNHN (38.6%) rate and higher than the NSW (35.4%) rate.

<u>Cervical cancer screening</u> participation rate among women aged **20-69 years (69.2%)** is higher than both SNHN (62.7%) and NSW (55.9%) rates.

Breast cancer screening participation rate among women aged **50-74 years in Lane Cove (42.6%)** is similar to the SNHN (41.8) rate and lower than the NSW (46.1%) rate.

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


