Mosman Local Government Area (LGA) is one of 9 LGAs in the Sydney North Health Network (SNHN) region.

Key Areas: Breast and bowel cancer screening rates, childhood immunisation rates and an older population

HEALTH DRIVERS

Mosman LGA is an affluent area, ranking in the least disadvantaged quintile (20%) on the index of relative socio-economic disadvantage.

CANCER SCREENING

Bowel cancer screening participation rate among people aged **50-74 years in Mosman (38.9%)** is similar to the SNHN (38.6%) rate and higher than the NSW (35.4%) rate.

Cervical cancer screening participation rate among women aged **20-69 years (72%)** is higher than both SNHN (62.7%) and NSW (55.9%) rates.

Breast cancer screening participation rate among women aged **50-74 years in Mosman (36.4%)** is lower than both the SNHN (41.8%) and NSW (46.1%) rates.




