HEALTH PROFILE

Sydney North Health Network (SNHN) is one of 31 Primary Health Networks (PHNs) in Australia covering 9

Local Government Areas (LGAs) in the Northern Sydney region.

Key Areas: Chilldhood immunisation rates, ageing population, breast and bowel cancer screening rates and a growing culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD) population

HEALTH DRIVERS

SNHN is ranked the least socio-economically disadvantaged PHN in Australia. However, there are pockets of high socio-economic disadvantage within Hornsby, Hunters Hill, North Sydney, Northern Beaches, Ryde and Willoughby LGAs.

CHILDHOOD IMMUNISATION

IMMUNISATION RATES LOWER THAN THE NATIONAL ASPIRATIONAL TARGET OF 95%



1-year-old 96.5% fully immunised NSW: 95.5%



2-years-old 93.8% fully immunised NSW: 91.7%



5-years-old 94.5% fully immunised NSW: 95.1%

CANCER SCREENING

Bowel cancer screening participation rate among people aged **50-74 years in SNHN (38.6%)** is higher than the NSW rate (35.4%).

Cervical cancer screening participation rate among women aged **20-69 years (62.7%)** is higher than the NSW rate (55.9%).

Breast cancer screening participation rate among women aged **50-74 years SNHN (41.8%)** is lower than the NSW (46.1%) rate.





Total population 922,349. Between 2021-2041, the total population will increase by 13% to 1,079,354

CALD

SNHN has a higher proportion of people culturally and linguistically diverse (29%) compared to NSW (23%). The largest culturally and linguistically diverse groups are Chinese and Indian.
