

DNEY NORTH HEALTH-NETV

Sydney North Health Network (SNHN) is one of 31 Primary Health Networks (PHNs) in Australia covering 9 Local Government Areas (LGAs) in the Northern Sydney region.

Key Areas: Childhood immunisation rates, ageing population, breast, and bowel cancer screening rates and a growing culturally and linguistically diverse (CALD) population

HEALTH DRIVERS

SNHN is ranked the least socio-economically disadvantaged PHN in Australia. However, there are pockets of high socio-economic disadvantage within Hornsby, Hunters Hill, North Sydney, Northern Beaches, Ryde and Willoughby LGAs.

CANCER SCREENING

Bowel cancer screening participation rate among people aged 50-74 years in SNHN (38.6%) is higher than the NSW rate (35.4%).

Cervical cancer screening participation rate among women aged 20-69 years (62.7%) is higher than the NSW rate (55.9%).


Breast cancer screening participation rate among women aged 50-74 years SNHN (41.8%) is lower than the NSW (46.1%) rate.


